- 1) 6:3.
- 2) We need four tins of white paint and one tin of red to make pink paint.
 - a) 4:1
 - b) 1:4
- 3) We need 4 oz of flour, 2 oz of butter, and 2 oz of sugar to make 8 cupcakes.
 - a) 4:2:2
 - b) 2:2:4
- 4) There are six boys to every 12 girls in Robyn's class.
 - A) 6:12 or 1:2
 - B) 12:6 or 2:1
- 5) Yes
- 6) Are the ratios 5/20 and 20:100 equivalent?

No. We need to multiply the denominator 20 by 5 to get 100, so the numerator also has to be multiplied by 5, giving us 25.100.

- 7) There are eight hens to one rooster in every flock.
 - a) 8:1
 - b) 1:9
- How do you write 5:5 as a fraction? 5/10
- How do you write 9/10 as a percentage? 90%
- 10) A shop sells 7 vanilla ice-creams to every 13 chocolate ice-creams. What is the proportion of vanilla ice-creams sold to the total ice creams? What percentage is that?

To get the percentage, we need to multiply the denominator by 5 to get 100, so we need to multiply the numerator by 5 = 35/100.

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
