
Answers Code week 13

Clue: Position, Shape, Shading and Size are important this week.

Remember to always look for the repeated letter first, and then see what is repeated in the drawing.



Answer: C (LY)


Repeated Letter: L = big shape.

M = small shape.

Mystery shape first letter L.

X = circle under square, Y = circle and square, Z = circle inside square.

Mystery shape second letter Y.



Answer: C (EL)


Repeated Letter D = upright shape.

E = shape pointing downwards.

M = half black, half white

L =white shape.

Mystery shape second letter = L.



Answer: B (CQ)

Repeated Letter C = vertical


D = horizontal

First letter of mystery shape is horizontal, so C_

P, Q, and R are all different. P = triangle, Q = pentagon, R = oblong.

Second letter of the mystery shape is _ Q_

CQ.



Answer: E (DS)

C = big circle


D = small circle

Mystery code starts with D = small circle

R, S and T are all different.

R = two circles, S = one circle, T = three circles.

Mystery shape has one circle, so second letter of mystery code is _S



Answer is: B (QJ)

Repeated letter: none on the top line

On the bottom line The repeated letter is _ H. H = inner triangle

I = inner pentagon, J = inner arch

Which is most similar in mystery code. _ J (remember it is the second letter you fill in for the bottom code.)

Q = outer shield, R = outer circle, S = outer arch, T = outer pentagon.

Which is most similar to mystery code? Q_

Code is QJ
