Refer back to the red box, put step 1 and step 2 together, both are a or d

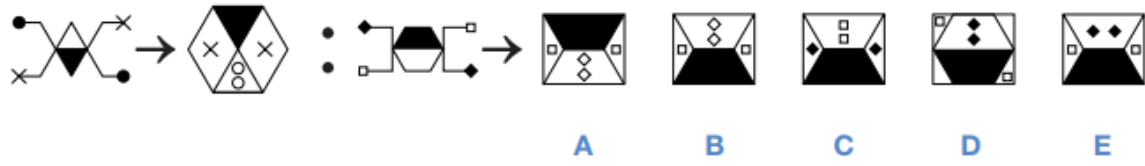

However, in the example pair, the inner lines of the second shape go diagonal, so it is a.

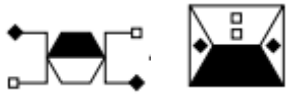

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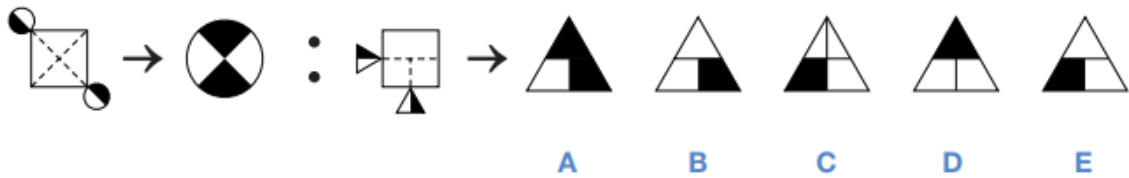


Tip: small outer shapes go inside the big shape. Note the change of colours.

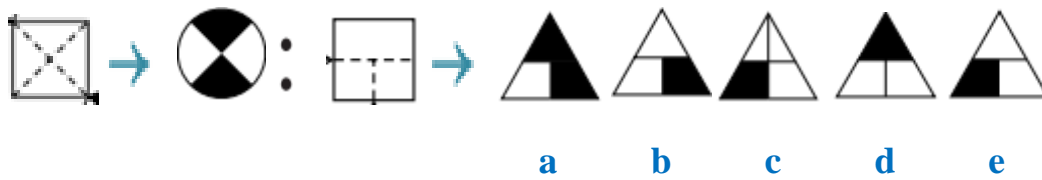

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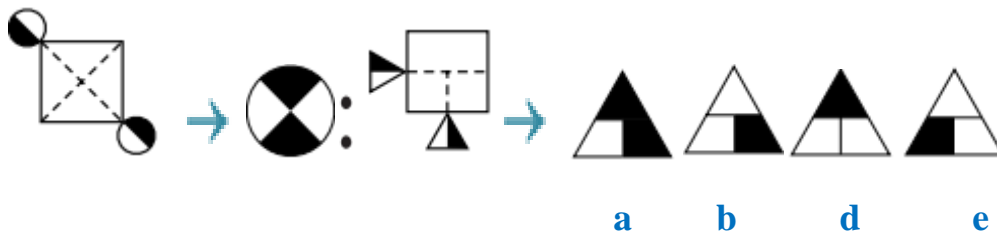
