By implementing the following key points, Tutor Doctor Bury St Edmunds aims to contribute positively to the fight against climate change while fostering a culture of environmental responsibility within the organisation.

1. Educational Requirements

 online climate change course provided by Green Suffolk
 (https://www.greensuffolk.org/climatechangecourse/). This course is designed to
 enhance awareness and understanding of climate change issues, enabling tutors to
 integrate sustainable practices into their work.

2. Minimising Travel

- Whenever possible, tutors will be matched with students for online sessions, reducing the need for physical travel.
- Whenever possible, tutors will be assigned to students based on proximity, minimising travel distances.
- Tutors are encouraged to choose sustainable modes of transportation, such as walking, cycling, or public transport, over personal car journeys whenever feasible.

3. Home Office Sustainability

- The home-based office at Meadow Garth, Mill Road, Pakenham,
- Bury St Edmunds, IP31 2NB, has been equipped with solar panels
- and batteries to harness renewable energy and reduce the carbon
- footprint of the office operations.
